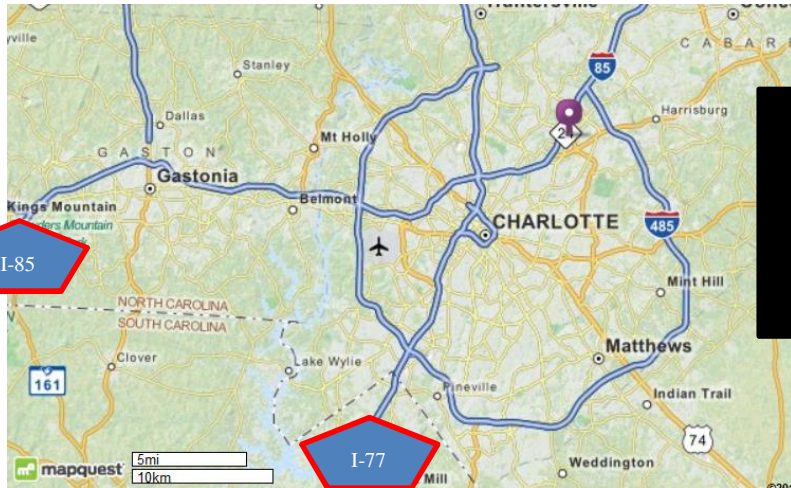

A Nuclear Regulatory Commission Public Hearing on Radioactive Waste is set for Charlotte, NC on November 4, 2013.

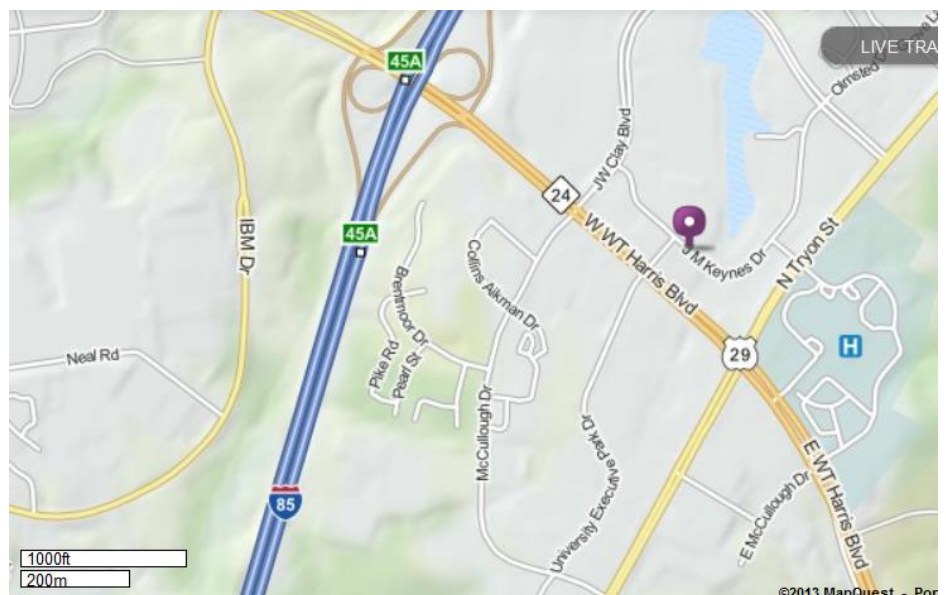
Location: Hilton Charlotte University Place, 8629 Jim Keynes Dr. Charlotte, NC 28262.

The NRC has scheduled public meetings to receive public comments on the **Waste Confidence Draft Generic Environmental Impact Statement (DGEIS)** and a proposed rule.

On November 4 at 7 pm, the NRC staff will begin with an overview of the DGEIS and the proposed rule. After that, anyone in the audience may speak to make comments. It is best to sign up to speak as soon as you walk in the door. The meeting will be transcribed, and transcripts will be added to the official record for consideration in preparing the final GEIS and rule.
