

Toxic and radioactive air pollution at Savannah River Site

The new air pollution permit for SRS would allow over 13 million pounds of toxic air pollution to be dumped into the air every year, including hydrochloric acid, arsenic, benzene, methyl ethyl ketone, mercury, lead, toluene, xylene and radioactive tritium.



The sources of air pollution include: coal-fired power plants, diesel generators, radioactive material processing plants, soil vapor extraction units, and a waste incinerator. Also, in the last ten years over one million pounds of toxic solvents have been emitted into the atmosphere by groundwater clean-up plants at SRS. This activity will continue for decades, adding many more tons of pollution to the air in the Central Savannah River Area.
