

Are You in the Fallout Zone?

Tennessee Valley Authority has submitted an application to extend the license of the Sequoyah Nuclear Plant for 20 additional years. An accident at this aging plant could contaminate people 50 miles away, an area of 7,000 square miles or more. The plant is located just 18 miles northeast of Chattanooga, Tennessee. Other towns within the 50-mile zone are Pikeville, South Pittsburg, Sweetwater and Athens, Tennessee, Dalton and Ellijay, Georgia, and parts of Jackson County, Alabama and Cherokee County, North Carolina.

The Blue Ridge Environmental Defense League is challenging the license for health and safety reasons. If you live in Tennessee, Georgia, Alabama or North Carolina within 50 miles of the plant (within the circle on the map), you may join this effort by signing a declaration of standing which will enable us to represent you in this challenge.


